Membership includes a subscription to the PCA's quarterly journal, IMPRINT.

Members can also subscribe to the PCA's Print Commission program for a recently released limited edition print.

As Australia's only art journal specialising in prints, each edition is full of news and information which is of vital interest to the artist, student and collector. Details of awards and competitions, exhibition reviews, critiques of current print media, articles on contemporary artists, research material, and technical matters are all included.

Imprint is excellent reading for all those teaching and studying the visual arts and provides information for the well-informed arts professional, as well as those developing an interest in prints and works on paper.

Print commission program offers limited edition prints by mail order

Each year the PCA commissions a number of artists, selected by a guest judge to produce limited editions of prints which are made available to members through our mail order program.

Individuals who purchase a print subscription select prints in order of preference from reproductions in the September Imprint. Prints are allocated and posted to subscribers prior to Christmas. Numerous public museums, local governments, schools and galleries have been long time participants, and many individual collectors continue to subscribe to this unique program, which supports both emerging and established artists.

The Print Council Archive

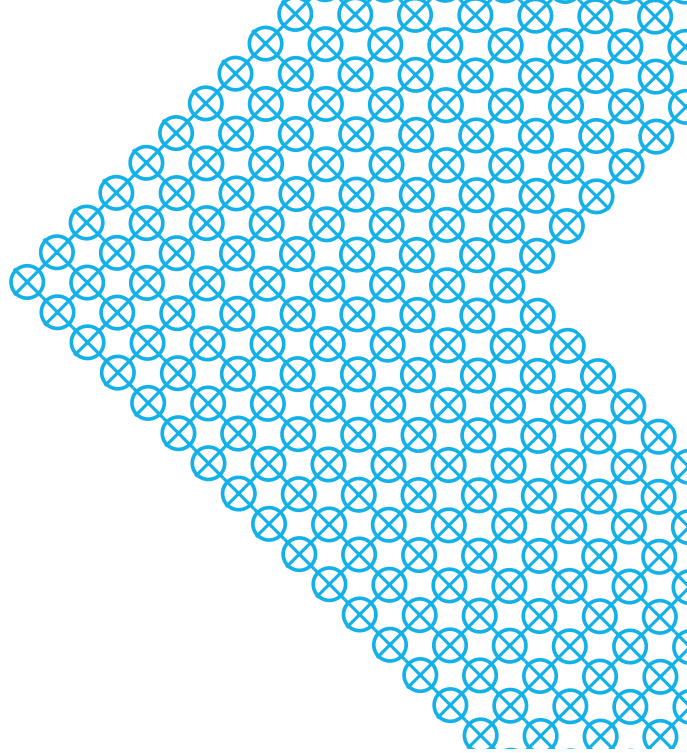
